Our privacy policy

This policy relates to our website – www.communityled.org.uk ("the Site"). Community Led Initiatives CIC is committed to protecting your privacy. This Statement of Privacy applies to the Community Led Initiatives CIC website and governs data collection and usage. By using the Community Led Initiatives CIC website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Information gathering and usage

We collect the following types of information from users of our website ("Users"):

1. Email addresses of Users who communicate with us via email or subscribe to any of our current or forthcoming services e.g. Newsletters;
2. Information volunteered by Users in the course of use of our website (such as, for example, survey responses);
3. Analytics and tracking data about Users site usage.

Unless we obtain your permission, information that is identifiable as relating to you (i.e. it has not been edited to make it anonymous) is not shared with or sold to other organisations for commercial purposes, other than under the following circumstances:

If it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of Terms of Service, or as otherwise required by law.

Your personal rights

You have the right to request we remove all personal identifiable information we store on you. Including the removal of any email subscriptions. To do so, please email hello@communityled.org.uk

The data we hold on you will be removed from our systems after a reasonable period unless we need to keep the information for legal or auditing purposes.

Cookies

A "cookie" is a small software file stored temporarily (session cookie) or placed on your computer's hard drive (persistent cookie). The main purpose of a cookie is to allow a web server to identify a user's computer and web browser, and tailor web pages and/or login information to the user's preferences. Cookies help us promptly display the information You need and other information which We consider to be of interest to You.

By gathering and remembering information about your website preferences through cookies we can provide a better web and marketing experience. Cookies don't give us access to users' computers, and the information we collect through cookies doesn't include personal information.

Essential cookies: Some of the cookies we use are critical to the functionality of our Site. They are used to keep a user logged into the Site and remember relevant information when the user returns to the Site and uses the Service.

Functional cookies: We also use certain cookies to track users' activities on the Site, understand their preferences within the Site and improve their user experience.

Marketing cookies: A third set of cookies is provided by third parties and allows us to deliver customised marketing information to our customers based on their Site usage profile and avoid delivering irrelevant marketing to customers.

Controlling cookies: you can accept or decline the use of cookies through a functionality built into your web browser. To learn more how to control cookie settings through your browser:

Data Storage

Community Led Initiatives CIC uses third-party vendors and hosting partners to provide services such as mailing lists. Data relating to Users and their organisations is transferred to or mirrored on servers within the European Union. Community Led Initiatives CIC reserves the right to transfer or mirror data to servers outside the European Union.

Community Led Initiatives CIC will apply all reasonable measures to ensure that data held on Our servers is secure but cannot guarantee that security measures will not be breached.

Changes to data storage

Community Led Initiatives CIC will occasionally update this Statement of Privacy to reflect user feedback and that required by law. Community Led Initiatives CIC encourages you to periodically review this Statement to be informed of how the Community Led Initiatives CIC is protecting your information. We will notify you about significant changes in the way we treat personal information by placing a prominent notice on our site.
